

The Big Island of Hawaii is known for its active volcano. Draw a path on the grid below to show the outline of the lava that has covered the island recently. The path must be a single continuous loop that travels along gridlines and does not cross or contact itself. Numbers specify how many of the sides of that triangle are on the path. (Note: Although the grid approximates the shape of the Big Island, the outline does not correspond to actual lava flows.) Explore outside the lava flow to find another feature of the island.

Read the letters outside the loop (blue letters) to get the instruction "Read interior letters by ones."

Those letters (red with yellow highlight) spell:

BLACK SAND BEACHES
